Student Dismissal/Student Pick-up

- Students must ride their assigned bus home and get off at assigned bus stop

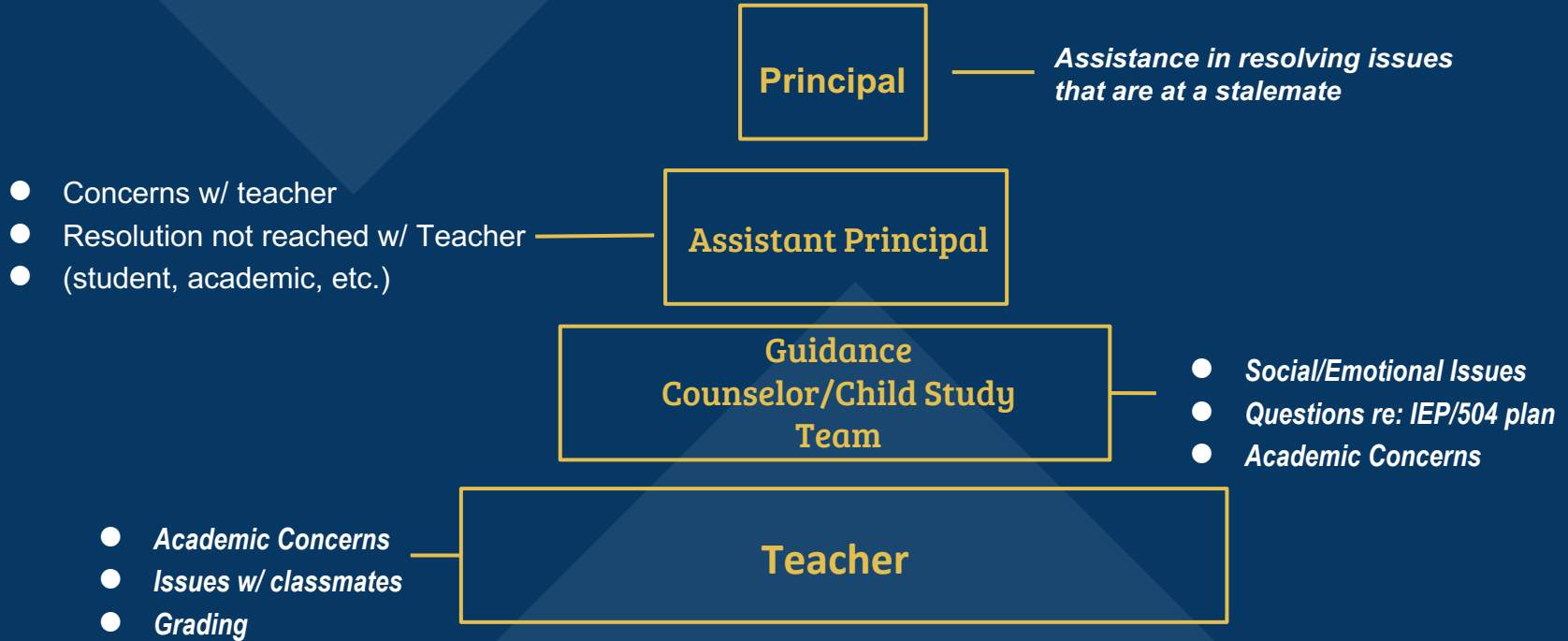
School Supplies

- Lists for each grade will be posted on the school website in mid-July
- Team Teachers will communicate any additional supplies needed
- All students will receive a locker to hold supplies
- Bookbags with wheels will not fit
- Lockers will be available during the summer to practice in July
- (1) planner will be given to each student
- Students' responsibility to write daily homework assignments & to make up missed assignments

Attendance

- Students are expected to be in HR by 8:00am
- Students taking the bus and arrive late will not be marked late
- Students in the Parent Drop-off lane after 8:00 will be marked late
- Communication is very important regarding attendance
